



LET THE MUSIC PLAY GRANT PROGRAM

CRITERIA FOR FUNDS AND EXCLUSIONS ON USE:

Grant funds are commonly used for the following:

1. Purchase or rental of musical instruments;
2. Repair costs of musical instruments
3. Purchase of sheet music for use in the program;
4. Reduce tuition costs for students participating in the program;
5. Fees of visiting teachers or clinicians for programs; and,
6. Supplement pay to music educators participating in the program.
7. Software, hardware, or services to support virtual learning.
8. Audio and video recording and/or editing professional services for virtual concerts.
9. Copyright expenses for recorded performances.

The Grant will not fund:

1. Commercial Organizations.
2. Grants by the applicant to other organizations for programming activities (“re-granting”).
3. Accumulated deficits or debt retirement.
4. Contingency funds.
5. Food or beverages for hospitality or entertainment functions.
6. Fines, penalties, interest on loans or costs of litigation.
7. Lobbying expenses.
8. Fundraising.
9. Individuals
10. Places of worship
11. Grants may not be made to organizations that discriminate based on race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, ancestry, citizenship, or disability status
