

LET THE MUSIC PLAY GRANT PROGRAM

CRITERIA FOR FUNDS AND EXCLUSIONS ON USE:

Grant funds are commonly used for the following:

- 1. Purchase or rental of musical instruments;
- 2. Repair costs of musical instruments
- 3. Purchase of sheet music for use in the program;
- 4. Reduce tuition costs for students participating in the program;
- 5. Fees of visiting teachers or clinicians for programs; and,
- 6. Supplement pay to music educators participating in the program.
- 7. Software, hardware, or services to support virtual learning.
- 8. Audio and video recording and/or editing professional services for virtual concerts.
- 9. Copyright expenses for recorded performances.

The Grant will not fund:

- 1. Commercial Organizations.
- 2. Grants by the applicant to other organizations for programming activities ("re-granting").
- 3. Accumulated deficits or debt retirement.
- 4. Contingency funds.
- 5. Food or beverages for hospitality or entertainment functions.
- 6. Fines, penalties, interest on loans or costs of litigation.
- 7. Lobbying expenses.
- 8. Fundraising.
- 9. Individuals
- 10. Places of worship
- 11. Grants may not be made to organizations that discriminate based on race, religion, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, ancestry, citizenship, or disability status
